- Organic and naturally grown produce is provided weekly by Calvert Farm, see typical harvest schedule. See website for harvest schedule: sandyspringcsa.com/harvest-schedule/
- Pick-up dates: Wednesdays, May 12 through Sept 29, 2010. We'll email exact pickup times.
- Total share price for returning members is \$545. For new members, add \$50. For each new site, a minimum of 50 shares is required by our farmer. If we don't reach the required number, then you can pick up at another site or have your money refunded.
- We don't take credit cards, checks only.
- Shares come pre-packed in boxes. Shares may be split among two or more people or two or more households. Members bear responsibility for divvying up the share.
- Checks are due now. All shares are on a first come/first serve basis
- 94% of your share cost goes directly to the farmers. The rest of the cost goes to administration

- All monies are non-reimbursable, unless otherwise noted. If you drop out, you can sell the remaining portion of your share. We can assist by notifying the waiting list, but we are not responsible for finding someone to take over your share.
